HOW TO ENTER ONLINE

Beginning 2/1/25, enter online at torch.ncseniorgames.org. Sign up online until the deadline of 3/19/25.

It is each participant's responsibility to ensure event partners are entered by the deadline.

Photo upload of your art is not required for online entry for BC Gator SG & SA. Any image can be uploaded to proceed with online entry. Actual photo (for H/V) is necessary for State Finals competition.

ELIGIBILITY FOR BC GATOR SG & SA

Men and women 50 years and older (as of 12/31/25) who have resided in NC for a minimum of 3 consecutive months during the last 12 months may participate in Sr Games & SilverArts. A participant's age on 12/31/25 determines the age category in which they will compete at Local Games and State Finals.

AGE CATEGORIES

Medals are awarded in each athletic event by age category (men/women separately): 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, etc. Medals will be awarded onsite for athletic events at the conclusion of each day's events. In partnered events, age of younger partner determines age category. Age categories **do not** apply for SilverArts or Cheerleaders.

FEES

\$15.00 fee includes a t-shirt, and entry in UNLIMITED Athletic/SilverArts events. Additional fees apply for Bowling (\$6) and Mini Golf (\$10). Meals and/or snacks and drinks included at most events.

2025 NC STATE FINALS ELIGIBILITY

ARTS

The following qualify for State Finals:

*1st place (overall winner) in Performing Arts (Follies).

*1st place in the Cheerleading.

*1st and 2nd place entries in each Literary Arts sub-category, provided the places are not won by the same artist (i.e. only one entry by the same artist per sub-category).

*1st, 2nd, and 3rd place entries in each Visual Arts and Heritage Arts sub-category, provided the places are not won by the same artist (i.e. only one entry by the same artist per sub-category).

ATHLETICS

The top 3 male and female qualifiers in each official NCSG athletic/event in each age category will be eligible to participate in State Finals except:

*All participants who complete in Fun Walk, Football Throw, and Basketball Shooting will qualify.

***Teams:** The 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place teams per the team sport age category will qualify.

The deadline to enter State Finals is August 1, 2025, at 11:59 pm.

National Senior Games is offered every two years for State Finals qualifiers. 2025 is not a qualifying year. For more info, visit nsga.com.

2025 ATHLETICS INFO

- Swim: Participants are limited to participation in 4 swimming events.

BE READY FOR YOUR SG ATHLETIC EVENTS

Arrive at the event location 15 minutes before the event begins or before scheduled event time. Each participant MUST have a photo ID available for check-in each day at each event. Upon arrival, check-in with the event manager.

2025 SILVERARTS INFO

***Entries must be the original work of the artist and must have been completed within 2 years of local games' submission date.**

Heritage/Visual Artwork Entries:

Artists must enter by deadline and indicate number of entries and sub-category. "Untitled" can be used if artwork has not been completed. Once registered, artists may change the entry and/or title of entry leading up to and on day of check-in at LCAC. Sub-category entered cannot change.

"Local Only" Sub-Category:

If the appropriate subcategory for an art entry is not offered/sanctioned by NC Senior Games, Inc., artists can enter artwork in the "Local Only" sub-categories. "Local Only" subcategories include Paper Arts (Heritage Arts) and Metalworking (Visual Arts). Art entries in "Local Only" will be judged and awarded ribbons but will not qualify to be entered at State Finals.

After entry by the deadline, how to submit Heritage/Visual Artwork:

Check -in for Visual and/or Heritage Art Entries will be held at Leland Cultural Arts Center between 9 am-11:30 am on Monday, April 28, 2025 at Leland Cultural Arts Center. Bring your entry to the door facing front on the far right side of the Center.

How to submit Literary Art Entries:

Artists must enter by deadline and indicate number of entries and sub-category. "Untitled" can be used if entry has not been completed. All Literary Art entries must be submitted by 11:59 pm on Wednesday, April 9, 2025. Submit literary art entries by email at k.haselden@brunswickcountync.gov or a hard/paper copy can be submitted in person/mail to BC Parks and Recreation(PO Box 249/20 Referendum Drive, Bldg G, Bolivia).

Judging:

Judging for Heritage/Visual/Literary Arts will be completed and Showcase on display on April 28, 2025. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons will be displayed in each category/subcategory of Heritage, Visual, and Literary Arts. **Unlike Athletic events, judging for SilverArts is not based on age categories.** Entries are judged by category/sub-category.

Public Viewing of SilverArts Showcase:

SilverArts Showcase will open for public viewing at the Leland Cultural Arts Center Gallery beginning Tuesday, April 29(9 am-9 pm), will continue April 30 (9 am- 9 pm), May 1 (9 am- 9 pm), and will close on Friday, May 2, 2025 at 11 am. SilverArts Showcase is free and open to the public.

Artwork Pick-up & COFFEE & CONVERSATION:

All artwork must be picked up May 2, between 11 am-12 pm. Early pick-up is not permitted. Receipt is required and will be checked for pick-up of art entries. BC Gator SG & SilverArts will not be responsible for art entries left after 12 pm on pick-up day. All participants are welcome to attend "Coffee & Conversation" to meet fellow artists and enjoy a last look at the SilverArts Showcase(see below).

2025 SilverArts Entries Specific Category Requirements

***All persons entering SilverArts must be 50 years or over as of December 31st, a N.C. resident for a minimum of 3 consecutive months of the calendar year, and must qualify through a local Sr Games SilverArts for State Finals.**

***Art entry/entries incorrectly categorized by the artist, or not in compliance with NCSG Guidelines and Requirements, will not be considered in the judging process.**

***Entries must be the original work of the artist and must have been completed within 2 years of local games' submission date.**

***ADDITIONAL INFO: see ncseniorgames.org/silverarts, (see SILVERARTS BOOKLET).**

A. Heritage Arts

- Entries must be the work of the individual and not a group.
- Heritage Art entries must be an original work. Patterns may be used, but no stamped pieces will be accepted.
- Pottery must be hand built or thrown.
- Entries from ceramic molds will not be accepted.
- All framed work must be securely wired, ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Two-dimensional work not properly framed and wired will not be displayed.
- Framed works can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- All entries, except framed work, **must be able to be displayed** (can be larger) in an area 3'(W) x 3'(L) x 5'(H).
- Groupings (sets) shall have no more than 3 separate pieces per set. All objects within each piece of the set must be contained within or attached to 1 of the 3 pieces.
- Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification.
- Artists, or their representatives, must be able to deliver and pick-up the entry at/during the designated times.
- The heritage arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.

B. Literary Arts (due 4/9/25)

- All entries must be typed, double-spaced, 8-1/2 x 11 paper and have a minimum of 1" margins. A minimum font size is 10-point type (prefer "times new roman" or "arial").
- Poems DO NOT have to meet double-spaced requirements.
- Poems can be no longer than 40 lines.
- Short stories, essays, and life experiences can be no longer than 8 pages.
- All entries must have a title page, which includes title of work, sub-category, and name of artist.
- Artist's name should not appear on the content pages.
- The literary arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.

C. Performing Arts

- An artist may only have one (1) entry per size of act in each sub-category.
- Performing entries are limited to three (3) minutes of on-stage time. Exceeding the time limit will result in automatic disqualification. Timing is the performer's responsibility and begins with the first note of music or the first movement visible to the audience and ends with the exit of the last performer from the stage or final movement of the act.
- Performing entries may be one of the following: (a) soloists, (b) small groups (2-4 performers), or (c) large groups (5 or more performers). Accompanist (s) will be counted to determine size of act. No one under age 50 as of Dec. 31st will be permitted on stage and an accompanist must be a registered participant.
- All performers for all acts must enter and exit stage left or begin and end on the stage.
- If recorded music is used, it must be an mp3 file (submitted by email or on a flash drive). Music may be picked up following the performance.
- State Finals, NCSG can provide the following items: chairs, microphone(s), piano and sound system. The act is responsible for all other props and equipment and must get NCSG advance approval for use at Show. Props must be small, few, light-weight and easy to set up quickly.
- Voice presentations must be a live performance by the artist. Background music can be recorded. Lip-synch is not permitted as a performing art.
- The performance at State Finals must be the same performance that won at the Local Games; i.e. same song, dance, music, etc.
- No live animals are allowed, except for service animals.

D. Visual Arts

- All artwork, except free standing pieces, must be framed (or gallery wrapped), securely wired, and ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Artwork, except sculpture, not properly wired will not be displayed.
- Artwork, except free standing pieces, can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- Sculpture groupings (sets) may have no more than 3 pieces per grouping (set).
- Photography Film or Digital-determined by the medium on which the image is recorded.
- Freestanding entries may be Sculpture, Mixed Media and Digital Art and must be able to be displayed in an area 3'(W) x 3'(L) x 5'(H).
- Artists, or their representatives, must be able to deliver and pick-up the entry at/during the designated times.
- If on-site assembly is required, details must be specified.
- The art piece must be an original work, not a print.
- Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification on the reverse side of entry.
- The visual arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.
